- To revise the lease of the Vandicourt area
- To ensure the continued provision of benches on the Public Rights of way
- To continue to archive the Parish Council's historical documents
- To reassess the outdoor gym scheme and its location and identify a potential funding stream
- To complete the sustainability elements of the Diamond Jubilee Play Area project.
- To remain a member of YLCA
- That two members attend the annual training conference
- For all councillors to attend training seminars where possible and as appropriate
- To provide four waste disposal skips for the village
- To produce four editions of the newsletter
- To continue to operate the Parish Council's website
- To facilitate the Micklefield in Bloom volunteer team's work
- To provide Christmas lights and trees around the village
- To submit a consultation response to every planning application in Micklefield
- To fit the solar lighting on the three entrance monuments
- To organise and pay for the grounds maintenance at Vandicourt and Micklefield Recreation Ground
- To carry out weekly inspections of the play facilities in Vandicourt and Micklefield Recreation Ground
- To arrange an annual inspection of the play facilities at Vandicourt and Micklefield Recreation Ground, by an accredited play inspector
- To maintain the two formal planting features at Garden Village bus shelter and Milestone Bankings
- To undertake at least two cuts of the relevant Public Rights of Way
- To continue to arrange the provision of the fibre broadband internet service and Wifi at Micklefield Youth and Adult Centre
- To submit at least one funding application to Hook Moor Wind Farm Community Fund
- To construct a seating shelter for the MUGA
- To firm up the Micklefield to Garforth shared footpath and cycle way project and identify a funding source
- To undertake a community consultation on options for the spending of the Parish Council's CIL money
- To assess and decide the merits of a lengthsman/handyperson for the Parish
- To assess the feasibility of village name signs for the three entrances to the village
