22/69/2 – BANK RECONCILIATION

Members noted a bank reconciliation to 31 October 2022.

22/70 - BRIDLEWAY DIVERSION PROPOSALS

22/70/1 - CONSULTATION PROPOSALS

Members noted Network Rail's consultation proposals, which included two proposed bridleway diversion routes through the Recreation Ground and that the Parish Council had responded in its capacity as a local authority and as sole trustee of Micklefield Recreation Ground Charity. Members also discussed the consultation event and the meeting with Network Rail representatives regarding the Leeds to Micklefield Scheme, notably the bridleway diversion proposals and the Ridge Road bridge works.

22/70/2 – CHARITY COMMISSION

Members noted that the Clerk had contacted the Charity Commission for advice to challenge the proposals and maintain the Charity's land for the Charity's purposes and was waiting for a response.

22/71 - HEIGHT RESTRICTION BARRIER

<u>22/71/1 – REPAIR UPDATE</u>

Cllr P Meir gave an update on the repair of the height restriction barrier. The parts had been fabricated and delivered to Brambledown Landscape Services Ltd, who would make the repair.

<u>22/71/2 – WARNING SIGN</u>

Cllr J A Crossley gave an update on the installation of a height restriction warning. The sign had been ordered; there was a two week lead time and the sign would be installed by Brambledown Landscapes Services Ltd at the same time as the repair of the barrier.

Members noted the installation of a key safe.

22/72 - 4 & 5 RAILWAY COTTAGES

22/72/1 – ELECTRICITY

Members noted electricity statements for the period 3 September 2022 to 2 November and that the account was £36.80 in debit.

22/72/2 - ENERGY BILL RELIEF SCHEME

Members noted that Micklefield Recreation Ground Charity qualified for the Government's energy bill relief scheme, that the new reduced unit rate was applied from 1 October 2022 and that the charity had received credit notes for the overpayments.

Members noted that Garforth Rangers AFC had agreed to accept and maintain a defibrillator donated by Taylor-Wimpey and kept in 4 & 5 Railway Cottages.

RESOLVED by unanimous vote to install a defibrillator unit in the changing rooms on the condition that it is owned a maintained by Garforth Rangers AFC.

Members noted that the defibrillator would need to be kept in a polystyrene box to insulate the battery and prolong its life span.
